On the edge of the famous limestone plateau of Saint-Émilion, Peter Sisseck (Dominio de Pingus) and Silvio Denz (Château Faugères) found in the lieu-dit of Rocheyron, 7.4 hectares of prime quality terroir.

These vineyards situated in Saint-Christophe-des-Bardes flaunt the pedigree of Saint-Émilion finest Cabernet Franc and the Merlot of 60 and 40 years old vines respectively.

Château Rocheyron organic viticulture respects the potential of the traditional vineyards and keeps the vinification in the cellar minimal. The main philosophy behind Château Rocheyron wines is to extract and infuse the very best of this classical and superb soil into the bottle.
